This document has two parts: **Part A — Publisher Terms** and **Part B — Buyer / Installer Terms**. Both parts are subject to the MSA and the AUP.

Part A — Publisher Terms

A.1 Eligibility and publisher profile

A.1.1 To publish, you must (a) accept these Terms, (b) complete a Publisher Profile, (c) provide accurate tax and payout information (PAN, GSTIN where applicable; international Publishers provide W-8/W-9 or equivalent), and (d) pass any required compliance / security review.

A.1.2 Publishers must be at least 18 (or the legal contracting age) and not be subject to sanctions.

A.1.3 Algoshred may verify Publisher organisations and require documentation.

A.2 Submission and review

A.2.1 Every public package — paid or free — must pass Store review before publication. Review covers security, malware, declared permissions, data access, manifest correctness, brand and trademark compliance, content policy, and basic quality.

A.2.2 Algoshred may reject, delist or require changes for any reason, including violations of the AUP, brand misuse, security risk, customer-trust risk, or pricing manipulation.

A.2.3 Updates to existing packages also pass review.

A.3 Licence grant to Algoshred

For each package submitted, Publisher grants Algoshred a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, sublicensable licence (to Customers per the install terms) to host, distribute, display, transmit, run, test, sandbox, and analyse the package solely to operate the Store and the Service. Algoshred acquires no ownership in the package's underlying code beyond this licence.

A.4 Revenue, payouts, and fees

A.4.1 Platform fee (per the Store Publisher Revenue Guide):

- Free public plugin: 0%.
- Paid public plugin, subscription, in-package purchase: **20%**.
- Tenant-private package: 0%.
- Special programs (meta plugins, enterprise org-wide licences): negotiated.

A.4.2 Customers pay in **Store Credits**; Algoshred credits Publisher with the publisher share (80%) on consumed credits for eligible purchases, less payment processing fees, refunds, chargebacks, taxes and any compliance withholdings.

A.4.3 Payouts are computed monthly, paid within **30 days of month-end**, subject to minimum threshold (default \$50 equivalent). Negative balances roll forward.

A.4.4 Taxes: Publisher is responsible for all taxes on its earnings. Algoshred may withhold tax as required by law (TDS, equalisation levy, GST for Indian Publishers — note: marketplace operators may have **TCS/TDS** obligations under **Section 52 of the CGST Act, 2017** and **Section 194-O of the Income-tax Act, 1961**). Algoshred will issue applicable forms (Form 16A / GSTR-8) where mandated.

A.4.5 Refunds: where Algoshred issues a refund to a Buyer (within the Store refund policy), the corresponding Publisher share is reversed.

A.5 Publisher obligations

Publisher shall:

- own or have all rights to publish the package (including any open-source compliance);
- accurately describe the package, its features, data access, network calls, and required permissions;
- provide a working version that runs as described in the supported VibeControls versions;
- promptly fix critical bugs and security vulnerabilities (target: critical within 7 days);
- maintain support per the stated support level for paid packages (default response 5 business days; faster for "Pro"-tier listings);
- comply with the AUP and applicable laws (DPDP / GDPR, export, sanctions);
- not include malicious code, undisclosed telemetry, miners, key loggers, or hidden ads;
- not include trademarks, copyrighted content or names owned by third parties without permission;
- maintain a public contact for security reports;
- accept Algoshred's right to suspend or remove the package for security or trust reasons.

A.6 Personal data within plugins

A.6.1 If a package processes Personal Data of Customer's data principals, Publisher is a Processor or independent Controller depending on architecture. Publisher must disclose this in the listing and (where Publisher acts as a Processor) make a DPA available to installing Customers.

A.6.2 Algoshred is **not** a party to the data-processing relationship between Publisher and the installing Customer.

A.7 Promotion and analytics

A.7.1 Algoshred may use the package name, logo and description for promotion of the Store.

A.7.2 Algoshred provides Publisher with usage analytics for its own packages and aggregate Store statistics, but not personally identifiable data about installers beyond what the Buyer chooses to share.

A.8 Term, removal, and termination

A.8.1 Publisher may delist a package at any time. Existing installations may continue to function under the previously-granted licence to Buyers, subject to support availability.

A.8.2 Algoshred may remove a package immediately for security or legal reasons. Otherwise Algoshred will notify Publisher and provide a remediation window where practicable.

A.8.3 On termination of Publisher status, accrued payouts on collected revenue continue to be paid in due course, subject to claw-back for fraud or refunds.

A.9 Indemnity and liability

A.9.1 Publisher shall indemnify Algoshred and Buyers against claims arising out of (a) Publisher's package, (b) infringement claims relating to the package, (c) breach of the AUP or law, and (d) misrepresentations in the listing.

A.9.2 Publisher's aggregate liability to Algoshred under these Terms is capped at the greater of (i) USD 25,000 and (ii) twelve times the average monthly publisher share earned by Publisher in the 6 months preceding the claim. The cap does not apply to indemnity claims under A.9.1, IP infringement, gross negligence, wilful misconduct, fraud, or breaches of confidentiality.

A.10 Open-source

If the package contains open-source software, Publisher shall comply with the applicable licences (including attributions and source distribution where required) and shall list components in the listing.

Part B — Buyer / Installer Terms

B.1 Relationship

B.1.1 The Store is a marketplace operated by Algoshred. Algoshred is the contracting party for Store Credit purchases and payment processing.

B.1.2 The underlying licence to use a third-party package is granted directly by the Publisher to the Buyer, on the terms displayed at the listing or on the Publisher's own End User Licence terms incorporated by reference.

B.1.3 Algoshred is **not** a party to the licence between Publisher and Buyer for third-party packages, and makes **no warranties** about third-party packages beyond the Store review process. Algoshred packages and Algoshred-published "first-party" packages are governed by the MSA.

B.2 Store Credits

B.2.1 Store Credits are an accounting unit, not legal tender or stored value, used to purchase Store items.

B.2.2 The currency-equivalent value, validity, and eligibility rules are displayed at issuance. Credits may have expiry, restricted categories, or restricted geographies.

B.2.3 Credits are non-refundable except (a) within Algoshred's published Store refund policy or (b) as required by applicable consumer protection law (e.g., **Consumer Protection Act, 2019** for Indian consumers).

B.3 Buyer responsibilities

Buyers shall:

- review the package's declared permissions, network calls, and data access;
- be solely responsible for vetting third-party packages for Buyer's environment;
- comply with the package's licence terms;
- not redistribute paid packages outside the licence scope.

B.4 Refunds

B.4.1 First-time purchase of a paid third-party package may be refundable within **7 days** of purchase, subject to the Store refund policy and provided the package was not materially used.

B.4.2 For subscriptions, cancellation stops future renewals; mid-period refunds are at Algoshred's discretion.

B.4.3 Refund disputes go to support@vibecontrols.com.

B.5 Removal of packages

If a package is delisted or suspended (e.g., for security reasons), Buyer's continued use may be restricted; Algoshred may, where appropriate, issue a partial refund or Store Credit.

B.6 Disputes with Publishers

Buyers should first attempt to resolve disputes with the Publisher. Algoshred may, as a courtesy, mediate but is not obliged to do so unless required by law.

C. Third-party integrations outside the Store

C.1 Where Customer connects the Service to a third-party system (GitHub, SSH targets, AI providers, cloud services), that third party's terms and privacy policy apply to Customer's use of the third party's service.

C.2 Algoshred does not warrant any third-party service.

C.3 Customer is responsible for the security, authorisation scopes, credentials and data shared with third-party services.

D. Compliance, AUP, governing law

All Marketplace activity is subject to the AUP. Indian law governs; disputes per MSA §15 (Chennai-seated arbitration; Chennai courts).
